

**Heirloom Crochet Cowl - Part 4**  
**Knit & Knot Yarn**

**Section 4: Diamond Lace 13 (26, 39) diamonds respectively**

Row 1- sc across. Join with sl st.

Row 2- ch 5 (counts as a tr and ch 1 in the first space), \*skip 4 sc (in addition to the first space at the beginning of the round with the slip stitch and ch 5), (1 tr, 3 dc, 1 tr) into next sc, ch 1\* Repeat from \* to last stitch cluster, ending with (tr, 3 dc) in the same sc as the ch 5 from the beginning. Slip st into 4th ch.

-Each set of clusters is worked on top of the V-stitch below. There is one longer stitch into the chain 1 space between the V-stitches, then 3 sort-of double crochets into the top (one dc into each dc below) and a longer stitch again into the chain 1 space on the other side. Then, you repeat, which means that there will essentially be two longer stitches into each ch 1 space below. Confusing? Try it, or watch the video tutorial! Sometimes it helps to just start crocheting.

Row 3- ch 4 (counts as first tr), YO. \*YO and insert hook into next dc. YO, draw through loop, YO and draw through 2 loops. Repeat from \* twice. YO twice and insert hook into ch 1 sp, YO and draw loop through, (YO and draw through 2 loops) twice, YO and draw through all 6 loops on hook. Ch 5. First cluster made.

All other clusters: \*\*YO twice and insert hook into same ch 1 sp just worked, YO and draw loop through, (YO and draw through 2 loops) twice. (YO and insert hook into next dc, YO, draw through loop. YO and draw through two loops) three times total. YO twice and insert hook into next ch 1 sp. YO and draw loop through. (YO and draw through 2 loops) twice. YO and draw through all 6 loops. Ch 5. Repeat from \*\* around, ending with a sl st in the top of the first cluster. Ch 1.

Row 4- sc around (5 sc in ch spaces, 1 sc in top of clusters). Sl st, finish off. Weave in ends.
